Financials:

Checking \$9,000

Deposits \$10,056.13

Expenses \$6,000- for 6 months of truck payments which are approximately \$766/month pay staff for outdoor season (no contracts have been received yet except Don U and Brett)-\$2,000 truck down payment-\$10,000 yearly audit \$5,200

Money market ended \$25,000

There was a question on how future funds for fundraising will be allocated. It was decided that all fundraising will go into a general fund and then will be distributed from there as needed.

At this current time, there is not adequate funding to provide \$20,000 for an indoor budget, but as fundraising is done, it will be determined from there what is feasible. We have lost approximately \$30,000 in fundraising opportunities this year as an organization due to

covid. We also have not yet received an official budget for an indoor season, and when that is finalized, decisions on what funds can be contributed will be made. At this time, no location has been secured for practice and an indoor season has not yet been decided upon.

Fundraising:

Janet Butterfield discussed upcoming fundraising.

- 1. The fry wagon will be doing an event on Friday 11/13/20 at the CV high school for the teachers and staff.
- 2. Middlesex Diner 11/11/20 all day-make sure to mention CV band so that we get credit.
- 3. Show shirt sale: We need 12 to be ordered to fulfill the requirements. Orders due 11/12/20.
- 4. R&K Sub Sale: delivered 11/12/20 and due to band practice finished, the pick up will be at Janet's home. Details will be sent out.
- 5. Steph Sevcik spoke about the upcoming Push-Save coupon fundraiser. Kick off meeting Thursday 11/12/20. This is an online coupon fundraiser in which the coupons can be customized based on the purchaser's location. This sale will contine through 12/20 and the band will make \$10 on each book sold. It is recommended that each student sell 6 books. Loren B. recommended that we get a group of students together to take ownership of social media advertising for this fundraiser.

Going forward, Lisa Underdonk volunteered to be the fundraising liaison for the band.

Josh B. spoke about securing an indoor facility for the indoor season. That is currently in process. He will work on a budget for indoor season and submit to the band.

Band Banquet:

Currently unsure how and when this will happen. Looking into possible venues that may be able to accommodate us in the spring with an outdoor option. This will be an ongoing discussion and will happen if possible.
