12/9/2013 Meeting Minutes: The minutes from the 12/9/2013 meeting are posted in draft form on the CVBB website. A motion was made and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Carol de Ramon

Every year we are required to do an audit. The audit for 2012 was paid for last month.

There are expenses coming in for the upcoming band banquet. Many of the indoor guard and percussion fees are already listed.

There are more uniform expenses coming for indoor guard.

Our 2013 ended better than expected because of the football team making the playoffs, so we had two more home games with concession sales.

The upcoming 2014 is a trip year to a bowl game, and will take place in December 2014. Grocery cards are the biggest fundraisers for student accounts. Next year's incoming freshmen need to be informed about grocery cards so they can take advantage of this fundraiser. Bob Seader is in charge of grocery cards.

A question was asked about the budget for the current indoor guard season. It was explained that the CVBB does have a budget that is designed with Mr. Porter. The prior board was in charge of the 2013/14 indoor season, and the budget was worked out with Josh for competition fees and uniform fees. Parents of indoor guard members say that the staff doesn't seem to be able to articulate their answers about the current budget for indoor guard. The design of show changes and affects the costs of the show, and those changes are made throughout the season. Parents of Novice Guard would like to know what the props costs. Abby gave a flag order last week and now she should have a better feel as to what the shows are going to cost. Josh has a budgeted amount for 2014 and has spent some money.

Last year's indoor show had budgeted \$16000+, which covered competition fees, props, uniforms, and staffing, etc. Carol de Ramon invited people with individual questions to speak with her after the meeting.

The CVBB Board and Mr. Porter are planning to meet to plan next year's budget very soon, and after that the CVBB Board will be able to share those numbers with other parents.

Selena suggests that the parents in charge of props should submit bills for props. The leader of Novice guard, Abby, should know how much she has to spend for her unit.

Director's Report: Dave Porter submitted the following report which was read aloud:

1. Mr. Porter will continue to send information via texts and Twitter. See his web page for more information about the text alerts.

- 2. Saturday, 1/18, 9a-12p, Eagle View band room, 1st Winter Winds rehearsal (all current and future members of the woodwind & brass sections of the marching band invited & encouraged to attend for a kind of "off-season training." Mellophones, Baritones, and Tubas will be provided. All other instruments must be brought by the students attending). Subsequent dates for this activity are:

 - b. 3/8 9a-12p, Eagle View Band Room

 - d. 5/10 9a-1p, CVHS Band Room with informal performance in the PAC
- 3. CV will be sending 20 students to the **2014 PMEA District VII Band Festival** on Saturday, February 8, at Central Dauphin High School. This is the most students we've ever sent to this festival, and CV will comprise nearly 15% of the entire band's population! Additionally, CV will be sending 24 students to the Cumberland County Band Festival to be held February 1st at Red Land High School. Congratulations everyone!
- 4. Remainder of **Basketball Band** schedule is posted on the band room white board. 2 games missed due to weather will not become a part of our performance schedule
- 5. **Jazz Band 3** started the rehearsals of the Jazz Bands on Wednesday. Jazz 1 & 2 will rehearse Tuesday, Jan. 14.
- 6. Received a grant for an electronic drum pad from the Eagle Foundation. This electronic device will assist us greatly in the design and performance of winter percussion and marching band shows for many years to come, and we're very thankful to the Eagle Foundation for their assistance.
- 7. Dustin Love participated in the **2014 US Army All-American Marching Band**, which performed at half-time of the 2014 US Army All-American Bowl Game, a premier Bowl Game for high school football players. The performance can be found at www.banddirector.com. It is a 3-hour long video, so viewers will want to skip to about 10 or so minutes from the end of the video to see the entire performance.
- 8. Cavalcade of Bands is sending an honor band to the Rose Bowl Parade in Pasadena, CA, for the 2015 Rose Bowl. Everyone, EVEN CURRENT SENIORS, are invited to apply and audition. Please visit www.cavalcadeofbands.org/TOR for more details. Deadline to apply is Monday, February 10. Students that apply/audition and make it will NOT be able to participate in the upcoming CVMB trip due to geography. I'm recommending this trip ESPECIALLY for current seniors who will either not be attending college or who will be attending a school that either does not have a marching band or will not be going to a bowl game. This will be a GREAT, once in a lifetime kind of experience for all involved.
